Course Description This course provides an introduction to environmental and natural

resource economics and policy. Lectures are designed to provide insights into economic aspects and a theoretical foundation of a wide range of environmental issues including air and water pollution, climate change, valuation of environment, management of renewable and non-renewable natural resources. Hands-on experiences with assignments with data analyses and in-class experiments are given an importance. The topics in environment and natural resource management in Turkey will also be

discussed.

Course Objectives By the end of this course, students are expected to (i) develop a capacity to evaluate the environmental/natural resources problem at hand, analyze the possible instruments, and assess the impacts of the chosen instrument.
